Findings

Finding	Risk	Recommended Action
Dating photo reused on public social profile	High	Use a dating-only image set and remove or replace the reused public image.
Bio detail matches public workplace clue	Medium	Remove employer-specific language and avoid routine/location hints.
Username connects dating profile to old forum account	Medium	Create a separate dating username that does not appear on older accounts.
People-search listing shows possible city/address history	High	Submit opt-out request and document removal status.

Priority Action Plan

- Day 1: Replace reused dating photos and remove workplace, school, neighborhood, and routine clues from the profile.
- Day 2-3: Separate usernames across dating, social, gaming, and professional accounts.
- Day 4-5: Submit opt-out requests for the highest-risk people-search listings found in scope.
- Ongoing: Recheck profile-to-real-name links after changes and maintain a removal log.
